What a crazy week we have had with weather. I have all my fingers and toes crossed we get a fine window for Kahu's camp next week at Guthrie Smith, Tutira.



Swimming: The pool is being used - please send clearly named swimming gear each day.




The final 2020 Scholastic **Book Club** flyers have been given out. Please have cash orders to school by Friday 4th December, or order on Loop for your convenience.
